Buddhism is an Indian religion attributed to the teachings of the Buddha, supposedly born Siddh rtha Gautama, and also known as the Tath gata ("thus-gone") and Sakyamuni ("sage of the Sakyas"). Early texts have his personal name as "Gautama" or "Gotama" (Pali) without any mention of "Siddh rtha," ("Achieved the Goal") which appears to have been a kind of honorific title when it does appear.
